Recently, the federal government passed SAFETEA-LU, the \$286.4 billion transportation bill, for roads, bridges, rail and bus facilities, bike paths and recreational trails.

Who better to give a perspective on what this will mean for Southern California than Norm King, a Coro alum and Executive Director of San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG). SANBAG is the transportation planning agency and council of governments for San Bernardino County. King has authored articles on the management and economics of local government in professional journals and books and is frequently interviewed for his unique perspectives on transportation and regionalism.
