### **OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM**

The Coro Southern California Executive Fellows Program is a part-time experiential leadership program that enhances and empowers a diverse group of professionals for effective executive-level leadership.

Through engagement with Coro's unique methodology and curriculum, Fellows will re-examine how they relate to the world around them and how others interpret their surroundings and experiences. Fellows will gain the skills they want and need to proactively adjust their behaviors to become more effective in addressing the issues facing their industries.

### **APPLICATION & SELECTION**

All application materials must be submitted to Coro Southern California either by email or mail.

Coro Southern California will review all written applications and select candidates to participate in interviews with a panel of community leaders. ### **PROGRAM STRUCTURE & OUTCOMES**

The Executive Fellows Program runs from September – June. Fellows meet for 1 full day and 1 evening every month for 10 months to participate in intensive seminars.
