



2010 Coro New York Alumni Award for Civic Leadership

Award Criteria & Information:

The Coro New York Alumni Award for Civic Leadership will be presented to one distinguished Coro alumnus/alumna each year who has contributed uniquely and meaningfully to civic life in New York City.

Criteria

The Award is intended to recognize a Coro alumnus/alumna who has demonstrated an outstanding commitment and contribution to the civic life of New York City. One winner will be selected for his/her record of developing effective solutions to public issues, influencing and inspiring others to affect change, and/or collaborating across sectors to achieve his/her goals.

Eligibility

Persons nominated must be a Coro alumnus/alumna from any Center who has met the aforementioned criteria in New York City. The honoree must also be able to attend the 2010 Coro Civic Leadership Awards Dinner on May 11, 2010 in New York City.

Nominations & Procedure

- Any person may submit nominations.
- All nominations will be treated in confidence.
- Nominations must be made on the official nomination form and reach the Coro Offices by the deadline.
- Nominations will include a description of how the nominee has contributed to the civic life of New York City in alignment with the award criteria, and the nominee's resume and/or list of civic activities.
- A diverse committee of alumni, Coro Board Members, Dinner Co-Chairs, and staff will review nominations and select the finalist.
